DBI CEO, ENGR. PROF. MOHAMMED AJIYA FEATURED LIVE ON THE TECH WEEKLY INTERVIEW KAFTAN TV (CHANNEL 124 , STARTIMES TV)

As part of the strategic efforts of the leadership of the Digital Bridge Institute (DBI) to broaden its engagement as a key stakeholder in the advancement of the ICT/telecoms industry, the President/CEO of DBI, Engr. Prof. Mohammed Ajiya featured in a live television interview in the weekly Tech session of KAFTAN TV. The interview was held on 25th June 2021 at the television studio of KAFTAN TV in Abuja Nigeria.

Prof. Ajiya stated that the Institute was established by the Nigerian Communications Commission (NCC) with the mandate of building capacity in ICT and telecoms to equip the Nigerian society with the needed skills to keep up with the evolving digital age. He noted further that in an interventionist approach, the NCC has continued to fund the Advanced Digital Appreciation Programme for Tertiary Institutions (ADAPTI) to provide capacity building intervention in the areas of ICT empowerment to train staff of tertiary institutions in Nigeria. The participants of the programme are over 120,000 staff of tertiary institutions in Nigeria and over 70,000 teachers of secondary schools across the country with a commitment from the NCC to continue to do more year in year out for seamless integration of a digitally focused economy.

He noted that the COVID-19 pandemic has made it apparent that the world can function well and sustain business engagements with the use of ICT and that is why the Federal Government is focussed on initiatives to empower the young and old to become more computer literate and become self-empowered through capacity building.

Prof. Ajiya further stated that the commitment of the Honourable Minister of Communications and Digital Economy, Dr. Isa Ali Pantami to a knowledge-based society through capacity building has brought impactful turn to the DBI and commended the NCC for the consistent support over the years.

In responding to the suspension of Twitter operations in Nigeria, he noted that there are ongoing discussions between the Federal Government and Twitter and it is going to yield the best results to the growth and advancement of the country.

He finally encouraged more young people to build their skills and make Nigeria proud among the comity of nations and he assured of DBI's readiness to support every steps to build capacity in the ICT/telecoms sector. He stated that the DBI is strategically located all over the country (Abuja, Kano, Yola and Lagos which are operational) and is well positioned to deliver trainings across the country.
